

## Public Transfer Ticket Information

The most comfortable but quite expensive way to the International Conference on Economics of Education is to take a taxi. Ask the driver to take you to **Rämistrasse 73 (University of Zurich, Kulturhistorisches Institut)** or to your hotel. This will cost about CHF 60 (taxis are fairly expensive in Zurich).

The least expensive and still quite convenient way is to take the train from Zurich Airport via Zurich Main Station (*Hauptbahnhof HB*) to the University (app. 30 min, 12 CHF). Trains leave every 10 to 15 minutes and take you in 10 minutes to *Zürich Hauptbahnhof (HB)*. From there you take tram #6 (direction Zoo), or tram #10 (direction Milchbuck) exit ETH/Universitätsspital (3 stations) to the university, or you take a tram to your hotel. At the airport, you simply follow the signs to the underground train station, which is located in the basement of the airport. Ticket offices and vending machines are also in the basement of the airport before you go down to the train platforms. Look for trains running to *Zürich Hauptbahnhof* or *Zürich HB*. **Please make sure you have a valid ticket before taking the last escalator down to the platform.** Tickets can be bought at the ticket shop or at the ticket vending machine. See below for a more detailed description of the ticketing machine.

### Tickets

All tickets are valid for all types of public transportation (trains, trams, busses, and ships) within the zone(s) you purchased. There are two types of tickets you should consider:

- One way ticket (6 CHF) from Zurich Airport to downtown, which is valid one hour and can be used for any destination in the city area (including the university and all the hotels we recommended).
- Return ticket (=day pass, 12 CHF) from Zurich Airport to downtown, which is valid 24 hours and can also be used for any destination within the city limits.

## Ticket Vending Machine



To use the ZVV ticket machine (ZVV = Zurich Public Transportation Network) you need Swiss coins and/or CHF 20 bills (not all machines accept bills). If you only have a credit or Maestro card, please buy your ticket at the ticket shop.

Use the ZVV ticket machine as follows:

1. From Zurich airport: Press the red button
2. The display shows the price for a 2nd class, *one way ticket*.
3. To switch between a *one way* and *return* ticket, use the  $\leftrightarrow$  button. The return ticket is valid for 24 hours and is also called a *Tageskarte* (day pass).
4. Insert the money using Swiss coins or — on some machines — a CHF 20 bill (no other notes are accepted). The machine will then print and drop the ticket and if necessary any change.

**For additional days you might consider buying a Day Pass for Zurich City (Zone 10).**

You get Zone 10 Day Passes at all vending machines. Just press the green button "*Tageskarte Zone 10*". The "*Tageskarte Zone 10*" costs CHF 7.80.
