Workshop overview

The workshop aims to intensively discuss research papers of the workshop participants with and by Prof. Lazear. Papers discussed should be either in the field of personnel economics or economics of education.

Objectives

After successful completion of the workshop participants are able to:

1. present their own research papers,
2. discuss constructively the research papers of other participants, and
3. prepare a “referee report” on one of the fellow student’s research project.

Prerequisite

Full working-paper.

Target audience

The workshop is designed for doctoral students in business economics, particularly but not solely from personnel economics or economics of education.



UZH Credit Requirements

1. Full workshop attendance. Students are expected to come prepared to the workshop. It will facilitate discussions and improve overall learning.
2. Presentation of own research project during the workshop and written “referee report” on one of the fellow students research project.
