6th Course Programme for Doctoral Students in Economics of Education

The Programme consists of four core courses and a variety of electives taught by distinguished faculty members of leading US or European research universities. The programme is similar to the first part of a PhD-programme of a top university in the US. The courses are usually taught at the University of Zurich and are one week intensive courses in order to make it possible for doctoral students from other universities to participate. Courses are free of charge for students who pass the selection process.
