## Leading House Best Paper Award 2023

Eligible for the award are all papers published in a journal<sup>1</sup> in 2023 that are authored or co-authored by a person working for the Leading House. Additionally, papers of PhD-students admitted to the Leading House Course Programme and presenting in the Friday Lunch Talk on VPET Economics are also eligible. Eligible papers must have been published in the Leading House Working Paper Series until one year after work with the Leading House has ended, or for PhD-students of the Course Programme until one year after the Course Programme or PhD is finished.

The Best Paper Award 2023 is awarded to the best published paper in a refereed journal on a topic related to the research areas of the Leading House VPET-ECON.<sup>2</sup> Two additional prizes are awarded as runner-up prizes. The Best Paper Award is accompanied with a cash bonus of 4'000 CHF for the best paper, and 2'000 CHF for each of the two runner-up prizes.<sup>3</sup>

The jury awarding the Leading House Best Paper Award consists of the members of the Advisory Board of the Leading House.
